WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICY

The educational institutions represent the main components of sustainability promotion in our society. The rise in the global population continues to contribute to the generation of waste especially in urban areas. This makes the issue of waste management to become one of the priorities for government and private entities. Waste is explained as most unwanted materials according to the Environmental Protection Act 1990. Waste includes any scrap material, effluent or unwanted extra substance or article that needs disposal because it is broken, worn out, contaminated or otherwise polluted.

Objectives

Waste minimization is very important because it makes good business sense to protect the environment and boost environmental performance. Waste Minimization techniques focus on preventing waste from ever being created, otherwise known as source reduction and recycling. Nehru College of Management, Coimbatore therefore commits to:

- a) Use two types of bins separately for biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes in the college campus as well as in hostels.
- b) Ensure that all cleaning products used by college staff have a minimal detrimental impact on the environment.
- c) Keep a stack of paper that has been printed on one side and use it for day to day rough paper work.

Waste Management Plan

Solid Waste management

- Solid waste is collected daily in dustbins located around the campus.
- The solid wastes like paper wastes, plastic wastes, food wastes etc., that get generated day to day are collected and segregated into biodegradable and non-biodegradable wastes.
- . The different waste groups have different colours for the containers/dustbins for the identification according to the hazards and are applied throughout the complete disposal chain i.e. Segregation, Collection, Storage, Transport and Disposal.
- * The recyclable garbage waste and non-recyclable wastes are dumped in specified coloured containers / dustbins.
- * A separate agency will be arranged by the management for waste collection and its proper disposal.
- . Disposal of sanitary napkins, batteries etc. Are done without causing any damage in the campus.

E-Waste Management

- · E-Wastes like defunct computers, printers, discharged batteries, UPS, Condemned electronic units, circuit components etc. are collected.
- Agreements / MoU's with approved agencies to handle the e-wastes are arranged by the management.

Water Recycling Management

- The waste water from various sources are collected and treated and further used for gardening purposes.
- Separate Posters on emphasizing the usage of water and its optimal use are displayed near water usage areas like Wash basins, Lavatories etc..

3. Construction of tanks and bunds







Water Conservation Policy

Preamble

Water is one of the fundamental scarce natural resource to life, livelihood, food security and sustainable development. India stands second in world population and has only 4% of renewable water resources and 2.4% of world's land area. There are further limits on utilisable quantities of water owing to uneven distribution over time and space. In addition, there are challenges of frequent floods and droughts in one or other part of the country.

With a growing population and rising needs of a fast developing nation as well as the given indications of the impact of climate change, availability of utilisable water will be under further strain in future with the possibility of deepening water conflicts among different user groups. Low consciousness about the scarcity of water and its life sustaining and economic value results in its mismanagement, wastage and inefficient use as also pollution and reduction of flows below minimum ecological needs. In addition, there are inequities in distribution and lack of a unified perspective in planning, management and use of water resources. The objective of the National water Policy is to take cognizance of the existing situation to propose a framework for creation of a system of laws and institutions and for a plan of action with a unified national perspective.

Objectives

Minimize consumption of water. In this context, Nehru College of Management, Coimbatore therefore has adopted the following policies.

- a) Repair sources of water leakage such as dripping taps and showers as quickly as possible.
- b) Install appliances which reduce water consumption
- c) Encourage use of recycled rain water and grey water to reduce main water consumption.
- Reuses the water coming out of RO water purification systems for washing clothes and garments in hostels.
- Use of an efficient and hygienic water storage mechanism to minimize the loss of water during storage.

Rain Water Harvesting

Rain water harvesting is an important environment friendly approach. It is a green practice having double benefit of keeping the groundwater level undisturbed and charging the aquifer. The college has constructed rain water harvesting (RWH) structures within its campus for storing and reusing the rain water. This green practice was encouraged in the form of Community Development Program.

The college organises programmes like guest lectures and seminars to sensitize students towards conservation of water. The soil in the college campus has a good infiltration rate. Rain water and run-off water are stored in a planned way which can save the earth from soil erosion and flood and recharge the aquifers to increase the groundwater level. Collecting and harvesting rainwater and run-off water would reserve the water for future generation. Rainwater harvesting is ecofriendly and economical. Our Institution is able to meet its water requirements through rain water harvesting and recycling.

Waste Water

Waste water generated by the college should be calculated and treatment plants should be installed as of requirements. The waste water after recycling could be used for cleansing of utensils and gardening activities.
